Over the years we have purchased an additional 50 plus acres to the initial 17 and grown the quarry into what you see today. CES operate a licensed recycling plant at Doran's Rock quarry, Saintfield. We are licensed to accept and process material arising from construction projects, demolition, road construction (including bitumen products) and concrete products, including solid dewatered concrete waste. Material from the different sources are graded before crushing, washing and screening into a range of aggregate tax free products.
